

## Final Project: HS Tech Web Page Grading Rubric (due May 07)

Your final web page topic will illustrate and describe three of any of the four modules you completed this semester. Use PhotoShop to make your screen shots into web images and Mozilla or GoLive to create and edit the web pages.

### I Naming (12 points total)

- 01 \_\_\_ The arrangement of all folders, web pages, and images is structured as shown in the figure below. (2 pts.)
- 02 \_\_\_ All folder and file names must use lower case, no spaces, and no symbols except underscore. (2 pts.)
- 03 \_\_\_ All web page file names have an .html extension. (2 pts)
- 04 \_\_\_ All images are saved for web as a jpg or gif and their file names have a .jpg or .gif extension. (2 pts.)
- 05 \_\_\_ The home page's file name is "index.html". (2 pts.)
- 06 \_\_\_ All web pages are named appropriately (as you would the title of a book: Capital letters where appropriate, spaces, etc.) and all page names show up properly in the title bar. (2 pts.)

### II Structure (16 points total)

- 07\_\_\_ The web page project consists of: a home page (file name: "index.html"), a bibliography page, and at least three other web pages (one web page for each of any three of the four modules you did). (3 pts.)
- 08\_\_\_ All pages follow the layout structure of the home page (index.html). (2 pts.)
- 09\_\_\_ Each page uses one invisible html table (border width = 0 pixels) to organize content. (1 pt.)
- 10\_\_\_ All html tables are centered on each page. (1 pt.)
- 11\_\_\_ All html table widths are 640 pixels wide. (1 pts.)
- 12\_\_\_ On each web page, there is at least one gif or jpg image that was made from a screen shot or photograph you took of your module. (6 pts.)
- 13\_\_\_ On each web page there are one to three paragraphs of text and each paragraph is made up of four to eight sentences. (2 pts.)

### III Size and Function (11 points total)

- 14\_\_\_ Image widths do not exceed the cell or row widths in which they are placed (i.e. do not exceed 640 px). (2 pt.)
- 15\_\_\_ There are no extra files in the media and pages folders (e.g. no .psd images here), nor in the folder that contains the index.html, media folder and pages folder. (2 pts.)
- 16\_\_\_ The biggest web image (.jpg or .gif) file size is not greater than 50 kilobytes. (1 pts.)
- 17\_\_\_ All web pages link to each other and no page links to itself. (6 pts.)

### IV Web Content (24 points total)

- 18\_\_\_ The home page's (index.html) written content introduces and summarizes your topic. Your topic is about any three of your four modules. (6 pts.)
- 19\_\_\_ The text on each of the three module pages (not your home page or bibliography) includes: what you learned by doing the module, how you solved problems, why you worked alone or with a partner, possible applications for the module and anything else you felt important about the completing module. (18 pts.)

### V Six Traits Writing (11 points total)

20\_\_\_ Voice: Your "voice" is individual, compelling, and engaging. A real person comes through the words and cares about his/her technology work. (3 pts.)

21\_\_\_ Conventions: All spelling, grammar and capitalization are 100% correct. (8 pts.)

### VI Publishing (13 points total)

22\_\_\_ Your web page is published to a geocities web hosting account (or other free web hosting account) and all links work properly and images show up correctly. (6 pts.)

23\_\_\_ Upon finishing the module, you will email Mr. Dierkes where exactly he can find the web files in your FirstClass and the URL of your hosted final project. (7 pts.)

### VII Ethical & Legal (13 points total)

24\_\_\_ The bibliography page lists all of the sources you used throughout your web page project (e.g. software, people, possible URL's, etc.). (4 pts.)

25\_\_\_ All written text and images are original: NO Internet images are used and all text is in your own words. (9 pts.)

Note:

- This entire web page (and the hosting) is done entirely by you. If there is evidence of cheating (e.g. not doing this on your own), you will receive NO credit for this final project.
- This final project counts as 16% of your overall tech grade. Each quarter counts as 42% of your overall tech grade.
- Submit partial final projects to get some credit in case you do not finish. SUBMIT SOMETHING! ZEROES WILL HURT!
- Build your folders based on the structure below. Use your FirstClass user name where you see "rdierkes".
